We hope your family enjoyed the holiday break. We would like to extend a very warm welcome to our new learners who will be beginning their learning journey at Takapuna Primary this term. We also welcome back Audrey Maratas and Stephanie Jackson who will co-teach Room 6B this year. Both Audrey and Steph have worked at TPS in the past and we are very excited that they have joined our teaching team again!

This week students have taken part in the Firewise Programme as part of the programme students learn about how to stay safe around fire. Next Thursday, local fire fighters will visit to reinforce the things we have learnt.

We will also celebrate Book Week next week. There will be lots of different activities for the children to take part in and on **Tuesday** students and teachers can come to school dressed as their favourite book character and take part in the Book Week Parade. There will be a book fair in the library before and after school each day.
