### Kia ora and welcome to Term 4 2023!

We hope you had a lovely holiday. A special welcome to our new learners and families. We hope you enjoy your time at Takapuna Primary. We have an exciting term coming up with our swimming and cross country being two highlights.

## Key Curriculum Areas

For our Strand Maths this term, the Year Ones are focusing on Geometry and Mapping. Here we will be learning the language of direction (especially the directions of left and right). Year Twos will focus on Transformation. Learners will be learning about lines of symmetry, reflections, rotations and translations. Later in the term, we will all learn about different types of measurement including capacity and temperature. Throughout the term, we will continue to develop our number knowledge.

In literacy, we are focusing on sentence structure. What a sentence looks like, how we read a sentence and how we can write a sentence. We will continue this focus during reading sessions, narrowing in on punctuation and using expression as the writer intended. As always, we continue to build knowledge of letter sounds and their combinations.

Better Start Literacy is a big part of our reading, writing and phonics program. We encourage learners to read one page at a time. We have created a few videos to share how learners read each page. Notice how the teacher pauses, prompts the learner with help and praises them. A Kakano book example video <u>here</u>. A Tupu book example <u>here</u>. The third video demonstrates how learners can move tiles to make and break (segment and blend) words in a word chain. See this <u>here</u>.

For our Inquiry this term, our Big Idea is 'Water is a treasure - Taunga te Wai.' We will be learning how water is a limited resource and how we can look after it.

# What's Happening This Term

We have swimming this term. This will be about learning how to be safe in the water as well as learning some skills. All children are expected to participate. Each child will need their swimwear and towel named.

This term we will be having a STEM open morning. For Kiwi this will be **before school** on **Thursday 9th of November from 8:30am - 9:30am**.

### Home Learning

We would suggest keeping any home learning light and short (around 15 minutes). The priority would be reading the reading book from school or reading to your child a picture book and talking about what happened in the story and explaining the meaning of new words.

Helping your child identifying numbers and counting groups of objects, such as toys in front of them can also be helpful. Click <u>here</u> to visit the NZ Maths website which has a lot of information about how you can support your child with maths at home.
