Changing Whenua (Turangawaewae) an inquiry into the Fossil Forest environment at Takapuna Beach, including the unique habitat, the history, and lava-preservation of plants. We will be learning about different types of fossils and how they are created. We will be visiting the Fossil Forest in Week 5. #### **Visual Arts**

Our inquiry learning based on 'Our Changing Whenua' will inspire us for our art project. Each class is currently doing a rotation with the Tūī teachers and exploring different mediums such as clay,

paper mache, painting, printing, collage with symbols and scratching. Learners will then choose their top three art choices and will complete an art project for the art exhibition in Term 4.
